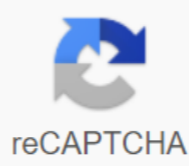

Tweet Earthquake Word Search Puzzle – Find and circle words related to earthquakes such as seismograph, liquection and epicenter in this educational word search puzzle.
